## Product Description:

A fresh vibrant Chenin Blanc with ripe flavours of white peach and pears, honey oats, lime zest and wet stone. The mineral palate is backed with balanced acidity.

## Harvest Notes:

The 2021 vintage was generally wet, but did not effect te early ripening Chenin Blanc grapes. This vineyard on the Helderberg Mountain slopes was planted in 1988 on granite soils and 320 m above sealevel. The yield is 3 ton/ha which gives us great concentration. The grapes were harvested on the 25th February.

## Vinification:

The grapes were brought in early in the morning and crushed straight into the press. The juice started a cold fermentation in the stainless steel tanks and after fermenting half of the sugar off, we decanted to one 500L Amphorae clay pot and two 500L older French oak barrels. After ferment the wine was kept on the leese for 8 months before sulphering and racking off the leese. Bottling was done in October 2021.

## Soil and Terroir:

This single vineyard are planted on a South-Western slope on clay soil with decomposed granite at 320m altitude.
